WOMEN UNITED PROGRAM PARTNERS

We invest donor contributions into five local programs that advance single mothers and their families through comprehensive support and move them toward financial stability. Our member-led Investment Committee determines where investments will have the most impact.

Project HOME - Quality Housing Coalition Direct cash assistance, individualized skillbuilding, and peer-to-peer support.

MomCore - York County Community Action Corporation

Targeted coaching program focused on improving financial knowledge and household stability.

Mothers Thriving - New Ventures Maine Flexible six-session class series, group support, and coaching to build confidence and skills.

Project WIN (Women in Neighborhoods) -The Opportunity Alliance

Gathers single mothers in a cohort and provides an evidence-based coaching model to help them identify and pursue goals for their families.
